Rails to Trails cleanup Sat.

The Greater Hazleton Area Civic Partnerships (GHACP) Rails to Trails Committee will hold a cleanup along the Greater Hazleton Rail to Trail Saturday from 8 to 10 a.m.

The public is invited to participate. The cleanup crew will meet at the Phase I trail end near Ashmore along the former Beryllium Road. The cleanup will concentrate on the area from the Beryllium road west for approximately 3000 feet. Everyone is asked to dress accordingly, with good boots, for a cleanup. Cleanup will be held rain or shine. Vests and gloves will be provided.

The Rails to Trails Committee will be sponsoring a hike on Sunday to take advantage of the peak of the fall foliage. The public is also invited to participate in this hike.

Walk master Bob Sagan will guide the group along a walk on the Broad Mountain that will be up to seven miles long. A shorter walk of less than 4 miles is also available.

Hikers are asked to meet at the former Dubatto's Restrurant on South Broad Street in Hazleton at 1 p.m.

Dress for a walk, with sturdy hiking boots, on non-improved roads and trails.
